

A Required prerequisite coursework includes:

- Statistics (this must be a stand-alone course)
- Biological sciences
 - Biology, Human Anatomy and Physiology, Neuroanatomy and Neurophysiology, Human Genetics, or Veterinary Science
- Physical sciences
 - Chemistry or Physics only
- Social/Behavioral sciences
 - Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, or Public Health

** Grades of "C" or higher will be accepted to meet the required prerequisite coursework.

Required foundational coursework (minimum of 15 credit hours from a university with accreditation from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA)) includes:

- Anatomy and Physiology of the Speech and Hearing Mechanism
- Speech and Language Development
- Speech and Language Disorders
- Audiology
- Speech and Hearing Science
- Phonetics
- Students must show evidence of a minimum of 25 hours in guided clinical observation in speech-language pathology and audiology prior to initiating graduate-level coursework.

** Grades of B or higher will be accepted to meet the required foundational coursework.

Students must also submit:

- Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
- One-page Statement of Interest in the Program at The University of Scranton (Times New Roman 12 font, double spaced)
- Resume
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
- Review and acknowledge the Essential Functions in Speech-Language Pathology document.

All materials pertaining to the application will be submitted through CSDCAS. Required

will be reviewed by the program. Applications can only be verified once CSDCAS has received all payments, transcripts, and letters of evaluation
